## Learning Leaflet

Our topic this half term is all about plastic and how it affects animals and our environment!



In **English** we will be learning to

- Learn, recite and perform poetry
- Write simple poems using our senses
- Make predictions about the key events in a story
- Infer the feelings of a character
- Take on the role of a character
- Write about an event from a character's point of view in the past tense
- Describe a setting in first person and the present tense
- Discuss and research an environmental issue
- Write factually to inform
- Use conjunctions to extend sentences
- Use commas in a list

In **Science** we will be learning to

- Identify things that are living, dead and never been alive
- Identify features of the main habitats of the world
- Identify and name animals in watery environments
- Describe how specific habitats provide for the species that live there

In **PE** we will

- Develop roll actions on the floor and using apparatus (Indoor - Gymnastics Apparatus)
- Develop skills in sending and receiving a ball through throwing, catching, kicking and using a racquet (Outdoor - Sending and receiving)

In **Maths** we will be learning to

- Add and subtract two digit numbers
- Compare number sentences
- Solve missing number problems
- Name 2d and 3d shapes
- Identify and describe 2d and 3d shapes
- Count the number of sides and vertices on 2d and 3d shapes
- Make and recognise patterns
- Draw and identify lines of symmetry



In **DT** we will be learning

- About a target market
- To design for a purpose
- To use running stitch
- To package a product and make it appealing
- To evaluate a design
- To make a seasonal mechanical card

In **Computing** we will be learning about

- Privacy and security online
- How content online may belong to other people
- How technology can affect our health
- What online bullying is and how to deal with it

In **PSHE** we will be learning about

- Taking care of our health and well being

In **RE** we will be learning about

- Why Christmas matters to Christians
- The meaning behind the celebration

In **Geography** we will be learning to

- Locate the seas and oceans around the UK
- Identify features of the coast
- Explore how people use the coast around the UK

In **Music** we will be learning to

- Understand how music can tell a story
