

# Autumn 1 Learning Leaflet – Snap, Crackle and ROARRR!

This half term we are learning about a **young boy called Eric** and the trouble he faces when he saves up coupons on a cereal box to win his **very own lion!**

In **English** we will be learning to;

- identify and use persuasive language and bossy verbs
- write a persuasive advert
- read a text and summarise the main points
- read and respond to a formal letter
- use apostrophes for contractions and to show possession
- identify and write in first and third person
- retell the main events from a story
- plan and write a story
- assess, edit and improve our own writing

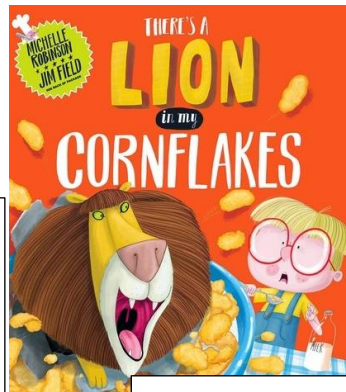
In **Maths** we will be learning to;

- Count in multiples of 2, 5, 10, 3, 6, 4, 8, 25 and 100.
- Find 1000 more or less than a given number.
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a four digit number (thousands, hundreds, tens and ones)
- Order and compare numbers beyond 1000
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations.
- Round any number to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000
- Count backwards through zero to include negative numbers.
- Read Roman numerals to 100 (I to C)
- Add and subtract numbers with up to 4 digits using the formal written methods of columnar addition and subtraction.
- Estimate and use inverse operations to check answers to a calculation.
- Solve addition and subtraction two step problems.
- Measure and calculate the perimeter of a rectilinear figure (including squares) in centimetres and metres
- Convert between different units of measure [for example, kilometre to metre



In **Science** we will be learning to;

- recognise that living things can be grouped in a number of ways
- explore and use classification keys
- construct food chains identify producers, predators and prey
- recognise that environments can change and this can sometimes pose dangers to living things



In **Geography** we will be learning to;

- Understand where our food comes from
- Map food imports
- Understand why different foods grow in different biomes
- Describe the journey of a cocoa bean
- 

In **RE and PSHE** we will be learning about:

- Hinduism
- Families and relationships

In **PE** we will be learning how to;

Indoor – Dance

Outdoor – Basketball

In **DT** we will be learning to;

- understand and apply the principles of a healthy diet
- select from and use a wider range of ingredients
- prepare a savoury snack
- evaluate our ideas

In **Music** we are learning to;

Use body and tuned percussion to recreate rainforest sounds

In **Computing** we will be learning to;

- understand which programmes and apps are suitable and why
- use excel to collect, sort and present data
- understand how to report inappropriate content
- understand the effects of talking to strangers
