Dear Parent/Carers

This letter is not meant to alarm and it is just to reassure you that as a school we are now taking measures to prevent the spread of the Coronavirus-Covid 19 gaining momentum. We have no cases in Redditch at this present time.

However, to continue to help prevent the disease as a school we are now going to do our utmost to slow the process down in our community. As you know we have been giving out key messages about hand washing and Catch it, Bin it, Kill it, so now we are going to cancel/postpone events in and out of school where significant groups of Parents/Carers come together. From tomorrow they are

- Year 3 production
- Pyramid music festival
- Parents evening 18th/19th March

- Safer internet parent's information session

In school we will also be reducing the number of children we have in assemblies and the number of children we have in at any one time. As you can appreciate we are in uncharted territory at the moment.

As a school we have not taken the above measure lightly and I have been in discussions with the other Headteachers in the MTM Alliance and our overall concern is the safety and welfare of children, staff and community -
