Dear Parents and Carers

All schools should be a safe place for children, parents/carers, staff and visitors at all times. The majority of parents/carers respect this and we thank you for that. Occasionally I get reports from a small number of parents/carers that say they feel a little uneasy on the playground due to the action of other parents/carers who make inappropriate comments or they approach their child about something which happened in school.

We therefore kindly ask that you all respect each other and if you have a concern you raise it with the class teacher directly (see Parental Behaviour Policy on the website under Key Information).

If a dispute arises between parents/carers and is carried on away from school, it is advised that school stay out the dispute. However, if the dispute takes place on school premises, this may be a safeguarding concern and we may be forced into taking action. This could also mean that the parent/carer may be prevented from entering the site, either temporarily or permanently.

So let's ensure that we all work in partnership to make the playground a welcoming and positive place for all.
