Up until Christmas, we are learning ...



In **English** we will be learning to;

- Use adjectives and noun phrases in poetry
- Write shape poems
- Recite poetry
- Write a letter
- Write a recount
- Write in the past tense
- Write factually and present a non-chronological report on our learning
- Read, sequence and retell a story
- Vary conjunctions and sentence openers
- Edit and improve our writing

In **Science** we will be learning;

- How solids change when squashed, bent, twisted and stretched
- About famous scientists and how they have affected life today



In **Maths** we will be learning to;

- Recognise number bonds to 100
- Add and subtract 10s and 1s
- Add and subtract two digit numbers
- Solve problems using addition and subtraction
- Check calculations using the inverse
- Recognise and use the symbols for pounds and pence
- Make money using different coins

In **History** we will be learning about;

- A significant person from British history, Guy Fawkes
- The events that took place and the reasoning behind Bonfire Night celebrations
- Coughton Court, a local historical building and will also be finding it on a map which is linked to our Geography

In **DT** we will be learning;

- About a target market
- To design for a purpose
- About types of fabric and stitching
- To package a product and make it appealing
- To make a mechanical greeting card

In **PE** we will be learning to;

Indoor - perform a range of balances and join them together to create a well-coordinated sequence both off and on apparatus
